Dear Parents and Carers

Opening TCLT schools during the Coronavirus Outbreak

We have received further clarification from HM government on the provision of care during the coronavirus outbreak. Yesterday we began to ask you to self-identify if your child would be eligible but I would like to draw your attention to the first part of the guidance stating that **if it is at all possible for your child to be at home then they should be.**

Guidance goes on to state that your child will be **prioritised** for provision if your work is critical to the COVID-19 response or you work in one of the critical sectors, and **you cannot keep your child safe at home.**

Today I am asking Headteachers and school staff to consider the lists we assembled yesterday and ensure that the children on the list have to be in school, as there is no alternative care for them at home, or they are considered vulnerable and will be better supported by attending school.

There is no requirement for you to send your child to school, even if they would be eligible.

Your school, will contact you today, either by phone or email to check that you intend for your child to come into school on Monday morning and we will then work together across the MAT to ensure that we have sufficient staff to meet the need. If we do not we will prioritise our lists. Please remember that we are also working without key staff who are ill, vulnerable or self-isolating.

Your child is likely to attend their own school initially but this may change. I would also like to draw your attention to the fact that this will not be a normal school day – we will be providing **care** to allow essential workers to continue to go to work.

The purpose of the school closures is to allow social distancing measures to be implemented so please help us by taking up a place in school, only if your child cannot be

cared for safely at home. Schools will essentially be closed to all but a very **small** number of pupils.

Thank you for your patience. This is a fast -changing situation and we are responding to events as best we can.
