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## Transition Day Tasks

### Personality portraits:

We would like to find out a bit more about your personality and interests. We thought that it might be a good idea to do this in a creative way! Your task is to create a personality portrait like the one below. A portrait is a picture of a face. This piece of work will tell us all about you, what you look like, what your personality is like, and what you are interested in.

To create your personality portrait, you will need to follow these steps.

1. Draw the outline shape of your face from a front view. There are different ways to do this: you could use a mirror to look at your reflection and draw the outline of what you see on to your paper, you could use the template on the following page as your outline, you could trace the template on to your piece of paper as your outline, or you could use an online drawing tool such as Sketchpad 5.1 to draw a digital version. If drawing is not your thing you could use a photograph.
2. Split the outline in half vertically. This could be with a straight line or you could give your line shape (wavy, curvy, zigzag, jagged etc).
3. On one half, draw the features of your face. This can be in any style that you choose. You could make it realistic, or cartoon like, or abstract.
4. In the other half, think of things that show something about you. You could fill this side with drawings of objects that you like, logos of brands that you like, your favourite characters from films or books, words that describe you. Anything at all that you think tells us something about you! If you don't feel confident with drawing everything, you could use words or cut pictures out of newspapers or magazines and stick them on instead.





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
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## All about me:
